Summary of Placer County, Nevada County, and Town of Truckee Housing Elements

What are Counties and Cities responsible for related to Affordable Housing?

The State does not require cities and counties to actually build the housing necessary to meet the community's needs. However, it does require that each community adopt policies and programs to support housing development, as well as designate adequate land at appropriate densities to meet the housing needs. Current policy allows different options for affordable housing, including the payment of in-lieu fees, the dedication of land, construction of affordable units or a combination of each.



What is a Housing Element?

The Housing Element is the main document that establishes the County or City housing policies. It is intended to ensure that decent, safe, affordable shelter is provided for all residents.

Every city and county in California is required to have a Housing Element. State law defines the specific topics that must be covered. These include:

An evaluation of existing housing policies and programs

- An inventory of all potential sites where housing may be constructed
- An analysis of any obstacles to affordable housing production in the community
- A needs assessment, based on data on demographics and housing conditions
- Goals, objectives, and policies, defining the community's position on various housing issues and setting measurable targets for meeting housing needs
- An action plan identifying the specific steps the community will take to implement its housing policies.
