<i>Tahoe Forest Hospital Update</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TFH is tracking data of emergency department visits as they have seen a spike in visits from residents at Coldstream Commons and Truckee Artist Lofts. As many are repeat visitors, it is becoming difficult to put together a legal discharge plan. • Jazmin is working with the property managers at each complex to improve communication and referrals for service. • CCTT is reaching out to property managers and is helping to coordinate support at a regional level. 	
<i>AMI Housing</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brown Bear Studios has the full set of building permits it needs to continue rehabilitation construction. There will be a construction kick-off meeting on 8/11. • Expected completion is this winter. 	
<i>Point in Time Count</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The 2022 Homeless Count is 41, down slightly from 2021 at 44 • Of the 41 people experiencing homelessness, 30 people in Nevada County and 11 people in Placer County. • 18 people were unsheltered, which meant they slept outside, in their car, or in other places not meant for habitation. 	

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 23 people were sheltered which means they were experiencing homelessness but on the night of the count stayed at the Emergency Warming Center, in interim housing like a hotel room, or at the Sierra Community House. 	
<p><i>MHC Quarterly Meeting Recap</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mike Dent provided an overview of Nevada County's Homelessness Action Plan at the MHC's quarterly meeting. View the recording here. • The seasonal workforce housing pilot program had a couple of meetings with prospective landowners and is in the process of drafting a proposal based on input from Telluride's pilot and the Summit County program.
